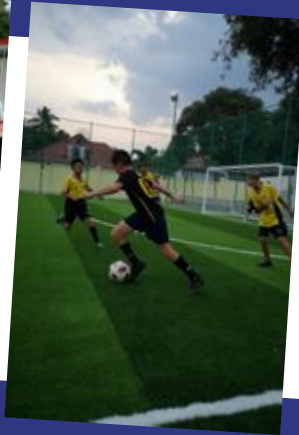


SPORTS NEWS FROM THE KESSEL LIONS

The team of CM1, CM2 and 6ème faced the International School of Myanmar this week! A defeat 9-0 but the morale remained at the top ... The revenge will come!

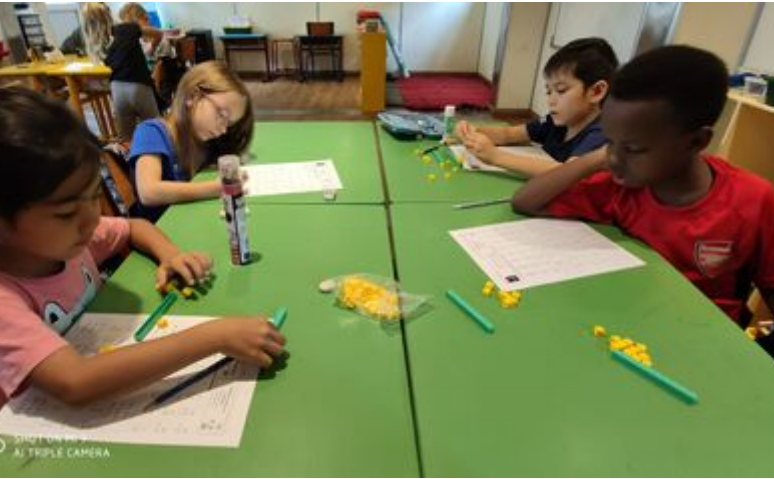


BASKETBALL

"Mental map" workshop for the CE1 students

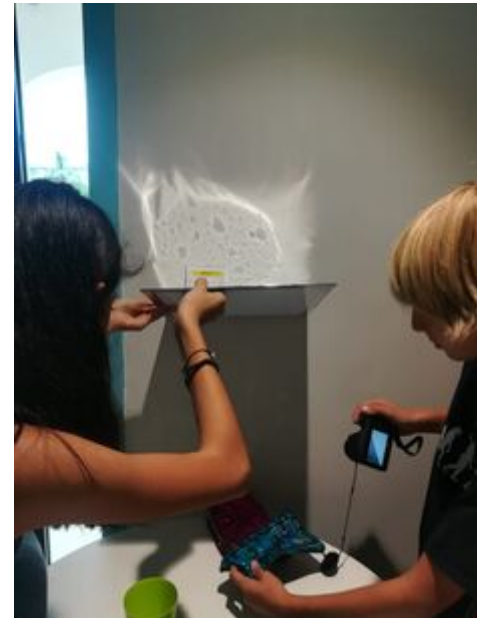


The CE1 during their sports session
